Policy Statement

All regular active emergency response members shall adhere to the following training requirements.

Members shall complete all of the following within the 1st 12 months of joining the fire department:

- 1) New Mexico Firefighter I – 80 hours minimum adhering to New Mexico Fire Training Academy position task book.
- 2) S130/190 (some online) – 16 hours minimum.
- 3) Hazardous Materials Awareness and Operations – 16 hours minimum
- 4) Firefighter Emergency Care – 24 hours minimum – as approved by EMS Medical Directors or equivalent.
- 5) Incident Command I-100 Online class (3 hours)
- 6) NIMS IS-700 Online Class (3 hours)

All interior structural firefighters shall complete the New Mexico Firefighter Qualifications System Firefighter I.

All personnel who drive units under 26,000 gvwr must have a valid New Mexico driver's license must also complete the Fire Department approved emergency vehicle operator course and receive district specific training on each type of apparatus they are approved to drive.

Any member who drives a unit having a GVWR > 26,000 must in addition, have a commercial driver's license or class E license.

- In all cases members may provide verification/validation of previous training which may meet this requirement; the County Fire Training Coordinator will review such credentials.
