

VALOR AWARD COMMITTEE GUIDELINES

To be approved for review by the Committee, candidate must meet these criteria:

1. Safety of the firefighter is the first concern.
2. Save a life.
3. Save property.

Other considerations should include witnesses from outside the candidate's district as well as witnesses from inside the candidate's district.

Candidate's letter should be presented to the Committee by the Chief of the candidate's district in a timely manner.

Committee should investigate fully all information presented to them and confirm with any witnesses.

At the conclusion of the committee's review, the committee's recommendation will be presented to the Chief's Association. At that time the Chief's Association will make the final decision.

Upon acceptance of the candidate by the Chief's Association, candidate will receive a plaque and a medal. Candidate's name will also be placed on a plaque in the Fire Operations Center.
